	ACTIVITIES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Use a numbered grid of characters that children will be familiar with to practise il/elle s'appelle. Ask the question Comment s'appelle le numéro...? Use the same characters and numbers to practise Il/Elle a...ans. Ask the question Quel âge a...? Point to a member of the class and ask the same questions for classmates to answer Focus on building sentences about name and age of siblings and friends (smaller numbers needed for age) Secret Sentence activity to practise saying someone's name and age Imaginary family tree to complete to practise the sentences Sentence builder to practise the sentences Stories, poems, songs and rhymes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Ma famille from <i>Singing French</i> <i>Petit Poisson Blanc</i> (Guido Van Genechten)

	Pos	<p>Listening:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - listen attentively to spoken language and show understanding by joining in and responding - appreciate stories in the language - understand facts <p>Speaking:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - engage in conversations - communicate facts <p>Reading:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - read carefully and show understanding of words, phrases and simple writing - appreciate stories in the language - develop their ability to understand new words that are introduced into familiar written material - understand facts in writing <p>Grammar:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - conjugation of high frequency verbs – être, avoir, s'appeler - gender <p>Language learning skills:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> - how the patterns, grammar and words of the new language are different from or similar to English – family words, verb s'appeler
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
