	ACTIVITIES	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Practise the months with actions Show children the written forms and talk about the roots of the month names and the fact that months in French don't have capital letters unless they are the first word in a sentence Use month/celebration dominoes to find out one celebration that happens in each month Find out about saints' days and the French custom of celebrating the day of the saint who has your name Introduce the question <i>Quelle est la date de ton anniversaire?</i>. Children answer using the formula <i>Mon anniversaire est (number) (month)</i>. Birthdays pair dialogue. Children can adapt to include their own birthday if they wish. Ask the question <i>Quelle est la date de l'anniversaire de...?</i> Children answer using the formula <i>Son anniversaire est le (number) (month)</i> Use sentence builder to practise sentences Stories, poems, songs and rhymes: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Joyeux anniversaire from <i>Singing French</i>
