NOTES FOR THE TEACHER:

The KS2 curriculum for Art requires that “Pupils should be taught about great artists, architects and designers in history”.

This activity enables children to find out about some French architects, sculptors, designers, photographers and painters while at the same time discovering the geography of France and building up some longer sentences in French.

Children will need access to the internet where they can search for the artists listed and use the information they find to build up a sentence about the artist. They will need something from each column for a correct sentence.
