	<p>ACTIVITIES</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Introduce and practise the 12 plural foods. Alternatively, practise the fruits and use the Tarsia puzzle to find out the vegetables Use <i>tengo hambre/sed</i> and <i>quiero comer/beber</i> to practise the foods as in 9A Children sort the foods into masculine and feminine, remembering what they know about spotting gender. Ensure they have noticed that all these foods are plural. Introduce <i>los/las</i> explaining that they are the plural forms of <i>el/la</i> and are needed in front of foods when giving opinions. Introduce <i>me gustan</i> = 'they please me', then <i>no me gustan</i>, <i>me encantan</i> and <i>odio</i>. Play Trapdoor to show how to build sentences with both singular and plural opinions, using conjunctions including <i>sin embargo</i> 	<p>PHONICS</p>	<p>ci / z j a h qu</p>
