

Covers

You can either print these out onto card, or cut a piece of A4 card into 8 equal pieces, which will end up being about 7.5cm x 10.5cm.

How to make your Aztec Codex:

- 1. Cut out the four pages in white paper.
- 2. Cut out the two covers in coloured card.
- 3. Overlap and glue together the four pages into one long strip and allow the glue to dry.
- 4. Cut the "overlap and glue" tabs off each end.
- 5. Fold the strip of paper on each dotted line and on the centre of each glued join to make a concertina or zig-zag.
- 6. Stick the covers onto the back and the front of the concertina.
- 7. Your Aztec Codex is finished! Now you can fill it.
 The Aztec Codex painters were called Tlacuilos, and they only used red, yellow, green and blue in their Codices.
