NOTES FOR THE TEACHER:

The KS2 curriculum for Art requires that “Pupils should be taught about great artists, architects and designers in history”.

This activity enables children to find out about some Spanish architects, sculptors, designers, photographers and painters while at the same time discovering the geography of Spain and building up some longer sentences in Spanish.
