- 1. Write down in French, in reverse order, (a) the odd numbers, from 99 to 49, then (b) the even numbers, from 100 to 50.**
- 2. Write down in French (a) the answers to the following sums: (i) huit + trois = ... (ii) onze – sept = ... (iii) dix × deux = ... (iv) trente ÷ trois = ... (v) seize + un = ...**
- 3. Write down ten more addition, subtraction, multiplication and division sums and their correct answers.**
- 4. Write as figures: trente-six; quarante-neuf; cinquante-trois; soixante et un; soixante-douze; quatre-vingt-quatre; quatre-vingt-seize; cent**
- 5. Write out all the odd numbers between 20 and 40 in French.**
- 6. Write out all the even numbers between 50 and 70 in French.**
- 7. Write out all the number divisible by 3 in French between 80 and 100.**
- 8. Write these sums and their answers as words: 5+8; 25–6; 4×10; 30÷5; 31+21; 45–4; 9×7; 63÷3; 87+13; 99–7.**
- 9. Write ten sums of your own with their correct answers, written as figures and as words.**
- 10. Design a French number wordsearch, using numbers between 32 and 100 as the hidden words.**
