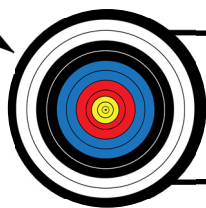


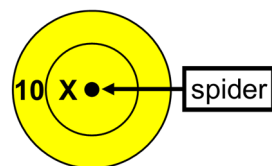
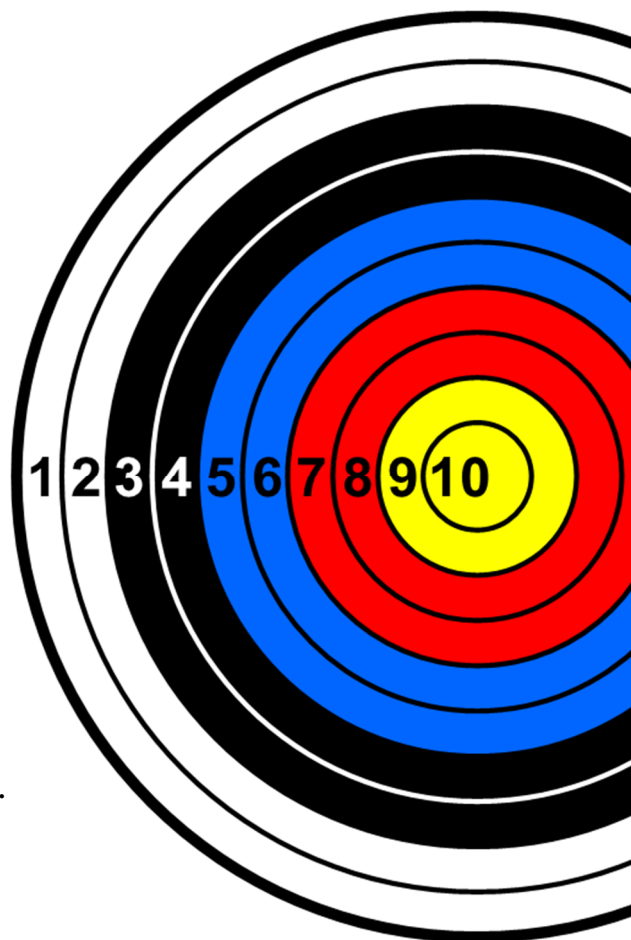

NOTES FOR THE TEACHER

Archers always aim for the gold 10 circle on the target, ideally the X (the inner 10 circle) and the spider (the exact centre of the target). The gold 10 circle is the size of a CD and so very hard to hit from the distance of 70 metres that is used in the Olympics.

By working out these sentences, students are encouraged to "aim for the gold". They can only get there, though, by practising and by hitting some other parts of the target as they go.

Students will be able to see how sentences can be built up from the very simple to the more complex, often by adding just a few words.

Recording their success with a tick or a cross in the circles at the bottom will enable them to see their success.
