In this lesson you will learn how to talk about presents, and what you do or don't like.

Presents

Here are some toys that children often ask for as presents.

le vélo	<i>bike</i>
le skate	<i>skateboard</i>
le ballon	<i>ball</i>
la peluche	<i>cuddly toy</i>
la poupée	<i>doll</i>
la console	<i>games console</i>
la voiture	<i>car</i>

Saying what you do and don't like

Here's how to express a simple opinion about one of these toys.

J'aime ça ! *I like it*

Je n'aime pas ça ! *I don't like it!*

Maintenant à toi. Ecoutez, répétez.

J'aime ça ! (pause) J'aime ça ! (pause)

Je n'aime pas ça ! (pause) Je n'aime pas ça ! (pause)

There is also a question that you can ask your pupils to elicit their response.

Tu aimes ça ? *Do you like it ?*

It is easy to adapt these opinions to talk about specific toys. For example:

Tu aimes la peluche ? *Do you like the cuddly toy ?*

J'aime la peluche. *I like the cuddly toy.*

Je n'aime pas la peluche. *I don't like the cuddly toy.*

You could also extend this by expressing opinions of things from previous lessons. For example:

J'aime le rouge. *I like red.*

Je n'aime pas le lundi. *I don't like Mondays.*

Tu aimes la France ? *Do you like France ?*
